Project Description:

1. Briefly describe the project. What was or will be done and where did or will the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were or will be involved?

Rural Philanthropy Days is a conference sponsored by the State of Colorado for nonprofit leaders. It will be held in Craig Co from September 27th - 30th. The conference convenes funding partners, nonprofits, County and City leaders to address regional social issues. The Conference has never been held in NW Colorado and will bring 300 - 400 people to Craig. The registration process for the conference is funded and managed through a cooperation between the Craig Rotary club and the Craig Chamber of Commerce. We plan on needing 2-5 members in two hour shifts from 3pm - 8pm on 9/27 and from 7am - 4pm on 9/28. We will need a majority of our 17 members to cover the 45 volunteer hours needed. In addition the Craig Rotary has a budget \$3,150 consisting of \$1,000 from the District and \$2,150 from the club.

We will also man the information table talking about the NW Colorado area and giving directions to the various venues being used for the conference.
