2. Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were involved?

A screen and projector were purchased. Every summer since (with the exception of the COVID-19 Summer of 2020) Platte Valley Bank of Morrill hosted three (3) movie nights each summer in the park for families of the community. PVC has two Morrill Rotarians that work for them. The school (two Morrill Rotarians work for Morrill Schools) has used the community screen for graduations and some professional development activities as well. The screen was also used for the projection for a community funeral with over 1000 in attendance. The Rotary club also used the screen each year for our Halloween themed "Eat, Drink & Be Scary" Reverse Raffle with over \$12,000 in prize money. This reverse raffle is our primary fund raiser for the year – resulting in over \$7,000 in proceeds and usually \$500-\$1000 raised for Polio Plus.

4. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Joe Sherwood a club member wrote the grant. The two Platte Valley Bank members organize the Movie Nights in the park – many Rotarians attend the event and also volunteer at the event. Many Rotarians attend or have roles in graduation, several Rotarians volunteered in several ways at the funeral and the entire club participates in the Halloween Fund Raiser.

The entire community benefits from having this equipment. Movies for all community families, graduations, funeral attendees, and nearly 100 community members participating in the Halloween Fund Raiser.

We purchased a bigger screen and a wide angle and reversible image projector. The screen can be shot at from the front or from the back with a reverse image. The Rotary Club used a Rotary debit card to purchase both online.

13. What worked well on this project and why?

The community had never had movie nights in the parks and we have had three each summer 2018, 2019 and now 2021 are scheduled. This screen was used for a funeral in the Morrill Schools Gym for a young lady (senior in high school) who tragically died the last Friday in August of her Senior year 2017. More than 1000 people attended the funeral. Graduations are attended each year by 600 – 1000 people in the school gym. Prior to the screen, the senior slide show was projected onto the concrete block gym wall which did not present an image very pleasant to view.

15. How was this project publicized? The Voice News Paper, Each night at Movies in the Park, the Rotary Club Banner is posted in the park and mentioned on the Public Address System. At the Funeral mention was made about the screen and projector being provided by the Rotary Club of Morrill. The Rotary Club is noted at graduation as well.


