1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Donations, Fundraising, and grants used to purchase school supplies for 2200 students, grades K to 9 at 3 schools located in Signal Hill, CA. Rotarians and community volunteers organize and packed supplies in backpacks and delivered to classrooms from July to Sept (Open House).

- 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Members from Signal Hill, Catalina, the ECLub of the West, District 5320 in excess of 50 members
- 3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. E Club partners with SIgnal HIII and provided volunteers and contributed grant funds; Members meet with teachers to develop supply list; ordered thousands of supplies; meet at delivery point and unloaded supplies; organized volunteers and set up assembly line on 4 days of packing; secured 70 rolling carts from EDCO recycling for delivery to school; delivered to schools and appeared for Open House to present supplies to parents/children. Engaged in community fund raising event and publicity.
- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 2200 students received supplies and teachers benefitted by not having to spend their personal funds to support low income children.
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Rotary recognized as major donor to local community; Community participation in charitable event; low income families received financial support.
- 6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? District 5320 provided volunteers. E-Club of the West partnered by donating their share of District Grants and volunteers. Long Beach Rotary Foundation provided major donation.
