Although the grand opening for the Housing First Collaborative project is still set for September, Juneau's four Rotary Clubs and one Rotaract Club will be celebrating "Bed Move-in Day" tomorrow at Allen Street location beginning at 10AM.

The multi-club effort, comprised of the Glacier Valley Rotary, Juneau Gastineau Rotary, the Juneau 58° Innovators, Rotary Club of Juneau (aka "Downtown Club"), and Juneau Rotaract Club (young professionals, 30 and under) will join forces to install 32 beds in the newly built facility. Funding came from the clubs as a match to a grant obtained from Rotary District 5010, which includes all of the Rotary clubs in Alaska and the Yukon.
