Project Title: Regional Scholarship Weld Rotary Clubs

Project Description:

1. Briefly describe the project. What was or will be done and where did or will the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were or will be involved?

The Greeley, Greeley Centennial, Greeley Red-Eye, Greeley After-Hours, Johnstown/Milliken and Windsor Rotary Clubs came together to offer a \$2,000 one-time scholarship for a college student whose major focused on one area of Rotary's emphasis areas. A team of four Weld Rotarians presented the proposed scholarship to Aims Community College. Aims Community College worked in partnership with the Weld Rotary 5440 Clubs to promote and support this scholarship. A team of four Rotarians reviewed applications and selected a student whose focus is on public health/nursing who plans to use her skills in Kenya when her college work is complete. The awardee has been able to focus on her studies as a result of this scholarship and avoid college loans. In addition, the overall Weld community will benefit from her nursing skills.

2. How many Rotarians participated in this project? (estimate if progress report) Approx 12 Rotarians from Weld Clubs.
3. What did or will they do? Please give at least two examples. Rotarians from various clubs worked in tandem to define the project, seek out other Rotarians in educational institutions to support this cause, review applications, follow-up with the awardee through club invitations and informal networking with other Rotarians in Kenya through the international conference in Atlanta.,,

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? (estimate if progress report). The Weld Community citizens who utilize medical services benefit from our awardee's scholarship as she is a student nurse presently. Fifty citizens a week benefit from her work as a student nurse drawing blood or working in the medical facility that analyses the blood.

5. Who are the beneficiaries and what is or will be the expected long-term community impact of this project? Through the nursing program, this grant will support the work of this awardee who will continue to work in Weld County as well as through a travel-study option in Kenya.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was their role? Aims Community College was a critical partner in the success of this grant. Aims Rotarians helped to ignite this college community to seek out applicants who would benefit from this grants as well as support one of Rotary's focus areas which in this case in maternal and child health.
