

BOARD OF DIRECTORS – VERDE VALLEY IMAGINATION LIBRARY

JEAN BARTON – President & Director Jean practiced and taught pediatrics for 40 years, first at the Children's Mercy Hospital in Kansas City and then at Hennepin County Medical Center (HCMC) in Minneapolis. She has been medical Director of the Pediatric clinics in both locations. She joined the Rotary Club of Sedona because it sponsors the Imagination Library. She became chair of the Verde Valley Imagination Library project in July 2016 when it expanded from Sedona and Rimrock to the entire Verde Valley.
