

## Project Title: **Repair Nepal School in 2017 DG P-1652**

**1. Project Summary:** Reconstruct the earthquake damaged Siddheswor Aadharbhut school, located in Manthali Village in the Ramechhap District of Nepal, to provide an adequate school building and supplies for 119 students now schooled in a temporary structure.

**2. Project Comment:** The villagers are happy to provide free labor to reconstruct their school. Rotary After Work and the District 5440 grant will provide funding for construction materials. Nepal Rotaractors, led by Rotarian Sudip Koirala, will be on site assisting and managing the reconstruction.

According to Sudip, “One very impressive thing is that villagers have not able to make their own home but also they are very excited to work volunteer to make their school for the children. Its heart touching.”
