Accessible Gardening Deck for the Cancer Support Community

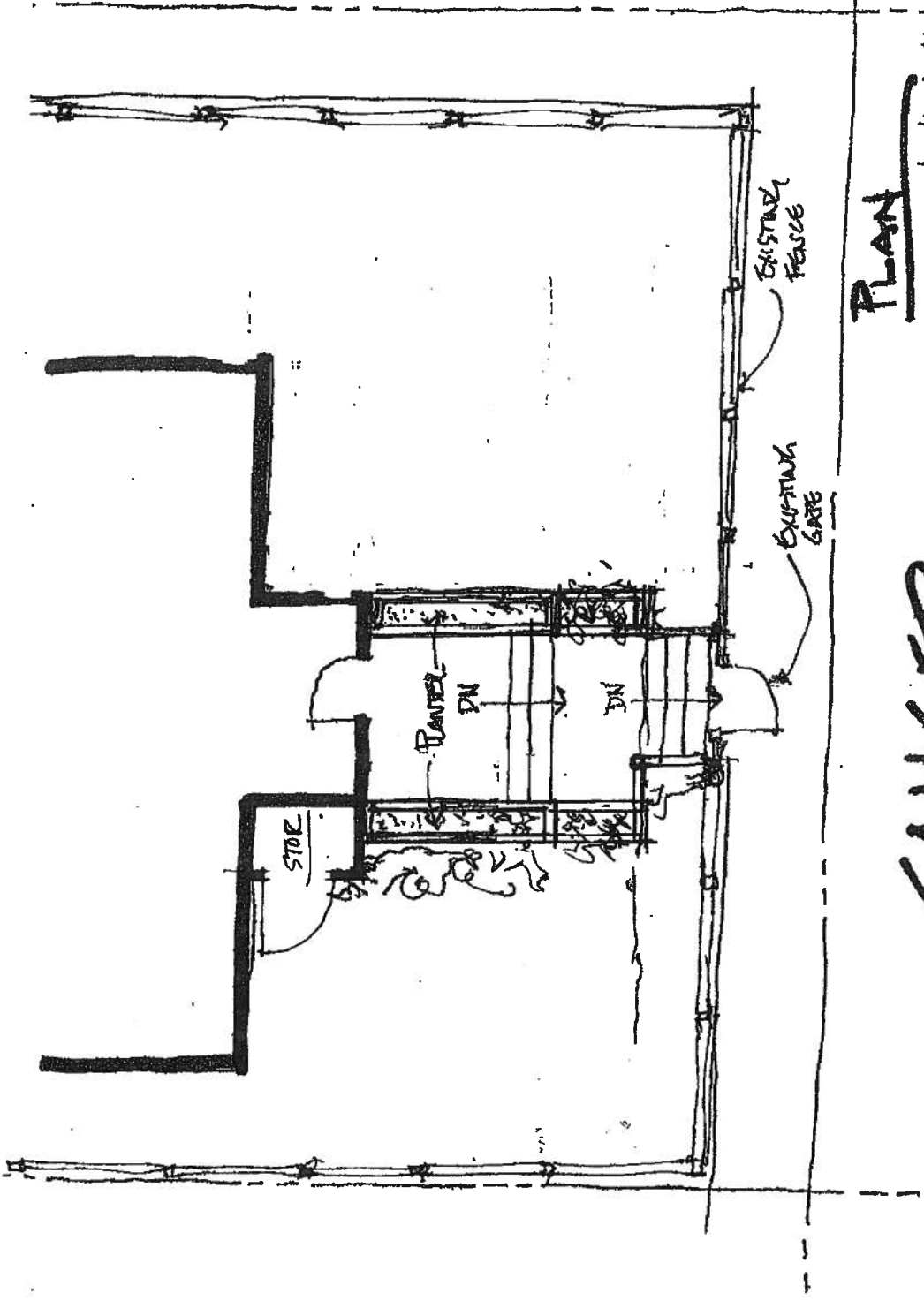
Kalispell Daybreak Rotary- District Grant Application

Kalispell Daybreak Rotary is proposing to build an accessible therapeutic gardening space for the Cancer Support Community in Kalispell, Montana. The concept of therapeutic gardening in the care of cancer patients and survivors has long been established. Research reports that moderate physical activity such as gardening on a regular basis helps to reduce the side effects of cancer and its treatment, including depression, fatigue, and decreased strength.

At the Cancer Support Community, participants currently participate in a limited, "traditional" ground level gardening space. Not only do participants receive the therapeutic benefits, but they also produce the foods that are used in the cooking classes offered at the center, establishing added value for the activity and resources currently available. Unfortunately, not all participants can access this space due to mobility and physical limitations that are sometimes present due to the cancer treatments being undertaken. This proposal is to transform an unused outdoor space into a deck that is accessible to participants of differing mobility levels where they can sit and tend their respective gardens in raised beds (please see the attached image and project renderings).

Kalispell Daybreak Rotarians will work under the supervision of the construction department of Kalispell Regional Hospital to construct the improved deck space and raised gardens. Daybreak Rotarians will purchase the needed construction materials and provide the labor to construct the improvements. This project will provide every Cancer Support Community participant the opportunity to garden as part of the recovery and therapy process. Additionally, the Cancer Support Community values the experience this provides their participants and the skills that it builds. As therapy does not end with time at the center, this activity can be transferred to home gardens and establish the habits that provide survivors with physical activity and healthy eating throughout their lives.

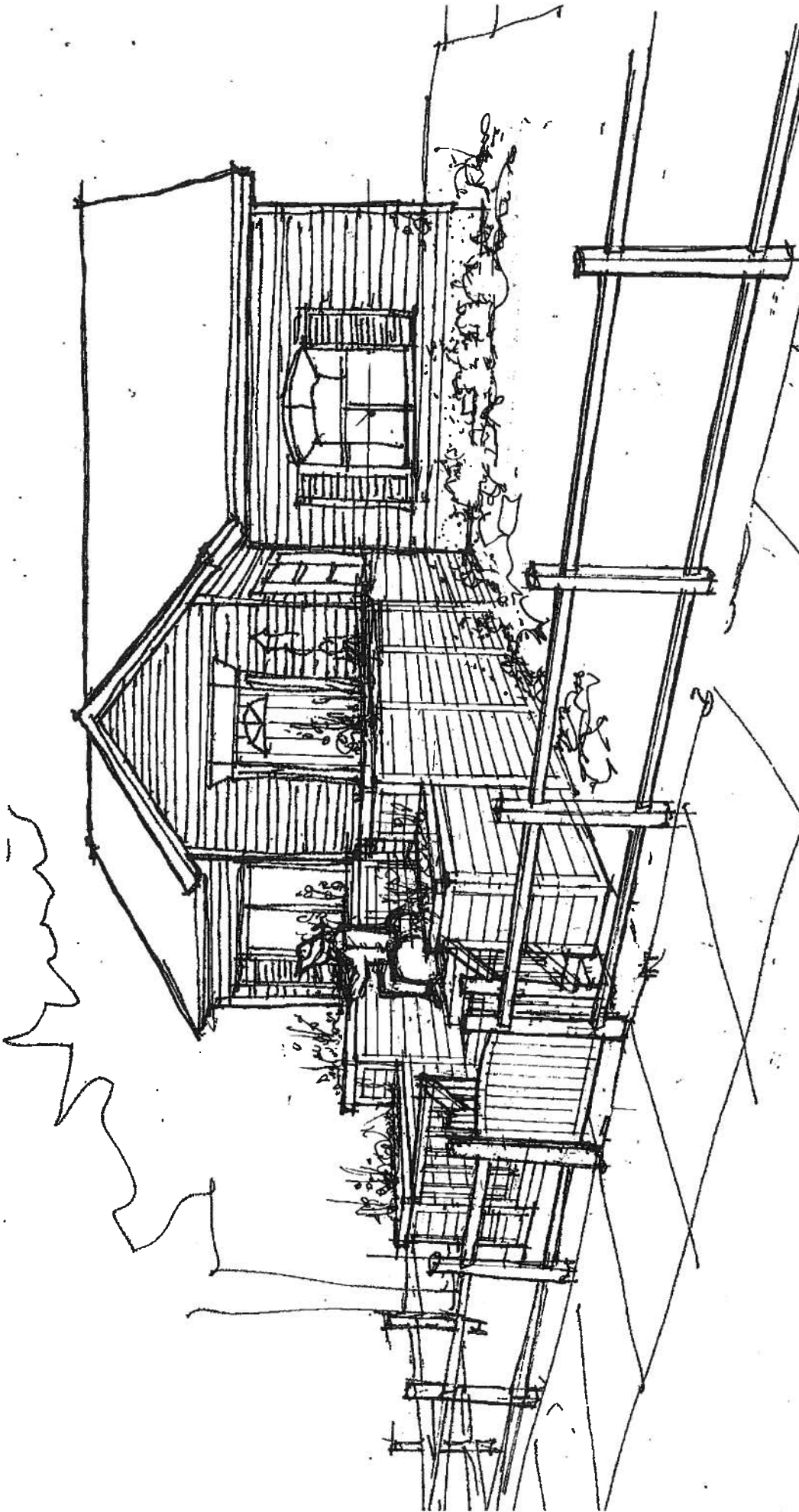
