The following list is an amendment to the District Simplified Grants submitted by Monarch Beach Sunrise Rotary in Nov 2012 for the SOCSA Foundation:

1) SOCIAL EVENTS:

Monarch Beach Sunrise Rotary Club has social events where members gather for an evening to attend and support SOCSA performances such as musicals and symphony performances at the high school. During the year, we will have about 10-20 Rotarians attend these performances as audience members, a critical part of participating in the show cheering on the student's performances.

2) VOCATIONAL TRAINING:

Monarch Beach Sunrise Rotary Club holds an annual vocational day for over 140 high school seniors, some of them SOCSA students from Dana Hills High School attend and go up to SCR - South Coast Repertory Theater (a professional theater) to get "hands on" experience by job shadowing a theater professional.

3) ROTARY SIGNING COMPETITION:

Each year, Monarch Beach Sunrise Rotary Club hosts 8 to 12 SOCSA vocal students who perform and are then judged by panel of Rotarians. A few of the winners then recommended to move on to the Rotary District 5320 signing competition. We have 1 lead Rotarian, John Hayden, who chairs this annual event, working with SOCSA's artistic director, Ray Woods, to organize this event held during one of our weekly Monarch Beach Sunrise Rotary Club meetings. We have 3 Rotarian judges and the entire club as the audience encouraging the student artists during this event.

4) ROTARIANS HELP BUILD SOCSA THEATER SETS:

Each year, SOCSA puts on 4 major productions, 2 straight plays and 2 musicals. During the school year, Monarch Beach Sunrise Rotary Club will have 10 members attend the set building event, painting sets, setting up props, hammering nails, etc. with Rotarians working side-by-side with the students who are building the sets for these products.
