Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The purpose of this project is to purchase 8 quick release microphone stands and an Epson Professional quality printer and supplies for The South Orange County School of the Arts (SOCSA) housed at Dana Hills High School. SOCSA is a visual and performing arts academy for students within the Capistrano Unified School District who have special interests and potential for creativity. These items will enable SOCSA to provide help to its 500 students enrolled in the Academy yearly, and additional non-SOCSA students from Dana Hills.

1) SOCIAL EVENTS:

Monarch Beach Sunrise Rotary Club has social events where members gather for an evening to attend and support SOCSA performances such as musicals and symphony performances at the high school. During the year, we will have about 10-20 Rotarians attend these performances as audience members, a critical part of participating in the show cheering on the student's performances.

ROTARY SIGNING COMPETITION:

Each year, Monarch Beach Sunrise Rotary Club hosts 8 to 12 SOCSA vocal students who perform and are then judged by panel of Rotarians. A few of the winners then recommended moving on to the Rotary District 5320 signing competition. We have 1 lead Rotarian, John Hayden, who chairs this annual event, working with SOCSA's artistic director, Ray Woods, to organize this event held during one of our weekly Monarch Beach Sunrise Rotary Club meetings. We have 3 Rotarian judges and the entire club as the audience encouraging the student artists during this event.

The purchase of this equipment will provide exceptional arts and career training as well as performance opportunities for the students, it will allow them to continue to bring the arts to wider audiences beyond their campus.

This equipment (printer, supplies and microphone stands) will allow SOCSA directly to meet the needs of our community. It will allow SOCSA to reach out. The students will create graphic design for use in print ads, magazine covers, brochures and programs to publicize the shows and community events throughout the year. In this way, SOCSA keeps community awareness. The quick-release microphone stands, will improve SOCSA performers. It will give them the opportunity to deliver higher quality performances at the Porthole Theater and community events at the Dana Point Yacht Club.
