The Del Mar-Solana Beach Rotary Club applied its \$750 in DDF monies to the \$750 registration fee for the one of the teams from Instituto Mexico Americano Noroest (IMAN), Mexico to participate in our Rotary MUN Conference this year. The San Diego Coastal Rotary Club applied its \$750 in DDF monies to the \$750 registration fee for one of the Mexican teams to participate in our Rotary Model UN Conference this year. The La Jolla Golden Triangle Rotary Club applied its \$750 in DDF monies to the \$750 registration fee for the second IMAN team to participate in our Rotary Model UN Conference this year. To comply with the DDF grant requirements, each of our Rotary Clubs sponsored at least one (1) local high school team and paid its \$750 registration fee for each of those teams to participate in our Rotary Model UN Conference this year. In fact, the La Jolla Golden Triangle Club sponsored 3 teams this year. This exceeds the DDF grant matching funds requirement. The DDF grant allowed more international teams to participate in our 2018 Model UN Conference. Since these international teams also need to pay for their transportation costs to come to San Diego for the MUN Conference, many of them would not be able to afford the \$750 registration fee. In addition, we were very impressed with the performances of the two IMAN, Mexico teams and the other Mexican team. The rest of the students really love meeting and making friends with students from other countries. The continued participation of international teams to our Rotary Model UN Conference makes it truly an international premiere event. It also continues to spark the interest of a growing number of US and Central American Rotarians to bring more international teams to our 2019 Rotary Model UN Conference! We would greatly appreciate the opportunity to apply for another DDF grant for the 2018-19 year to help facilitate these additional international teams participating in our MUN next year.

Under the above-referenced DDF grant, we received a total of \$2250. This was distributed by the District as follows: \$750 to the Del Mar-Solana Beach Rotary Club (DMSB); \$750 to the La Jolla Golden Triangle Rotary Club (LJGT); and \$750 to the San Diego Coastal Rotary Club (SDC).

As chair of the District 5340 Model UN Program, I received \$750 in DDF funds from DMSB, \$750 in DDF funds from LJGT and \$750 in DDF funds from SDC. I applied DMSB's \$750 to pay for the registration fee for one of the Instituto Mexico Americano Noroest (IMAN), Mexico teams to participate in our Rotary Model UN Conference on April 7-8, 2018. To comply with the DDF grant requirements to match the DDF funds of \$2250, DMSB, LJGT and SDC each sponsored at least one (1) local high school team and additionally paid the \$750 registration fee for those local teams to participate in our Rotary Model UN Conference this year. I confirm that as Chair of the District 5340 Model UN Program, I received \$750 from DMSB to sponsor 1 team from Canyon Crest Academy, at least \$750 from LJGT to sponsor 1 team from the Preuss School, and \$750 from SDC to sponsor 1 team from Mexico, for a total of \$2250. In fact, I received more than \$2250 from these 3 Rotary Clubs as LJGT sponsored 3 local MUN teams this year. This exceeds the DDF grant matching funds requirement. Please
