Several members of the Villa Park Rotary have been involved as volunteers at Cerro Villa Middle School.

Teaching Junior Achievement Classes, installing “Home Work Help” clipboards in classrooms, repairing exercise bicycles are some examples. While attending a monthly PFSO meeting at the school, the need for a Smart Board system was outlined by staff however no funds were available.

Villa Park Rotary DSG committee members went on line and did research relating to Smart Boards, related equipment and manufacturers. A committee member then met with School Principal Dr. Ken Miller to determine what exactly was required. Dr. Miller explained that the Orange Unified School District has an approved source for the equipment and the pricing is \$3034.00

Once the equipment is purchased, committee members will be on hand when it is delivered and installed. Members of the DSG Committee and Villa Park Rotary Club will attend a dedication for photos and a demonstration of the technology with student and staff participation.
