Hello! I hope you well.

Our work together over the years has been critical to keeping our hungry neighbors fed with healthy and nutritious food. I appreciate your email to me inviting St. John Lutheran Church Food Pantry to request a grant from the Rotary Club of Joliet District Grant. As you know from volunteering here, food flies off of the shelf as soon as we put it on there.
