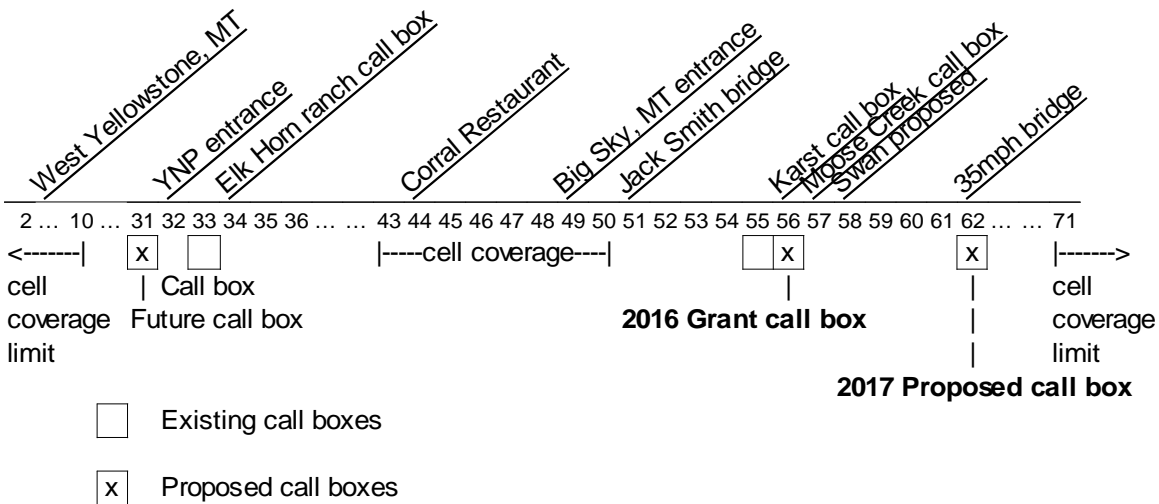


2017 Emergency Call Box Project Grant Application
 Rotary Club of Big Sky

- **Moose Creek (2016 grant) call box** – This area is heavily used by commercial rafting companies and boaters as a river “put-in”, also used by fisherman, and is the site of a popular campground. Replace existing call box with Rath solar call box and move location 500 feet south to entrance to parking area for safer vehicle pull out. Due to road reconfiguration, the existing call box location does not have any pull off area for vehicles. Existing call box cannot be reused. Existing southbound sign on west side of road can remain. One new graphic “phone” sign is to be installed 500 ft south of box on east side of Rt 191 for northbound signage.
- **35mph bridge (2017 grant application)**– This area is heavily used by boaters, commercial rafting companies, hikers, fisherman, and climbers. The proposed call box location is at south side of bridge turn out on west side of Rt 191. Box site is 5 miles north of Moose Creek call box. Two new graphic “phone” signs, approx 500 ft north on west side of Rt 191 and 500 ft south of box east side of Rt 191 are to be installed.
- **Yellowstone National Park YNP (future grant) entrance**– This area is heavily used by fishermen, hikers, horsemen, and tourists stopping at the YNP park entrance sign. New call box location is 2 miles south of Elk Horn call box. Fiber optics are on the opposite side of the road from the pull out. Two new graphic “phone” signs, approx 500 ft north on west side of Rt 191 and 500 ft south of box east side of Rt 191 are to be installed.
