

Report of the Reconstruction of the Home in Cuayuca de Andrade, Puebla, Mexico

The Rotary Club of Chicago Little Village applied for a grant, February 14, 2018 to rebuild a home in the small mountain town of Cuayuca de Andrade in the state of Puebla, Mexico after the devastating earthquake there in September of 2017. The grant was approved by the District 6450 Grants committee for a total of \$2,417.00.

The Rotary Club of Chicago Little Village (RCLV) raised over \$11,000 through several fundraisers at Mi Tierra Restaurant in Little Village, under the leadership of Dan Arce, Club President. The club also hoped to receive other donations but those did not materialize. The RCLV contributed the remaining funds of \$3,583.00 to make a total donation of \$6,000 (\$2,417.00 + \$3583.00) for the reconstruction.

The RCLV partnered with the Rotary Club of Puebla Mirador, (RCPM) to locate, estimate, document, reconstruct and supervise the reconstruction of a home. The RCPM found 6 homes in the small town of Cuayuca de Andrade, just a few kilometers from the epicenter of the earthquake which hit the state of Puebla.

Photos of the home, before and during the reconstruction, as well as 2 receipts for materials and labor, our budget and the grant check are uploaded on the District Grant website. The 2 receipts are uploaded with the photos as they are jpeg files.

Living in the home are a family with at least 1 child; Miguel Angel Ruiz, of the RCPM thinks 5 family members live in the home. We will confirm this and upload photos of the completed reconstruction and additional receipts when finished. Because of the deadline of July 1 for completing the project, we are submitting this report before the home is totally finished. All the District Grant funds have been spent and documented.

The house is the home of the Basilia Cabrera Ramirez family and the address is Calle Cenobio Andrade No. 22.

Estimated labor for reconstruction is \$30,000.00 pesos and \$12,000.00 has been spent. Estimated materials are \$74,000.00 and \$79,550.00 has been spent. Yet to be completed is painting and finishing clean up. \$91,550.00 has been spent so far, of the estimated \$104,000.00 pesos. We included \$388.82 in US dollars for supervision and unforeseen additional expenses in our budget which we hope will cover everything necessary.

We are very grateful for the support and trust of the Rotary District 6450 Grants Committee members as well as for the trust and support of the residents of Little Village, our donors and club members.
