We are pleased to inform you that the U.S. Board on Geographic Names, at its May 5, 2016 meeting, approved your proposal to apply the new name <u>Rotary Falls</u> to a waterfall in Matanuska-Susitna Borough. The name has been entered into the Geographic Names Information System, the nation's official geographic names repository, which is available and searchable online at http://geonames.usgs.gov. The entry reads as follows:

Rotary Falls: falls; approx. 100 ft. tall; located along an unnamed stream 1 mi. SSE of Government Peak; the name recognizes the work of several local Rotary Clubs; Sec. 21, T19N, R1E, Seward Meridian; Matanuska-Susitna Borough, Alaska; 61°43'12"N, 149°17'40"W; USGS map - Anchorage C-7 1:63,360.
