Dear Fred:

This letter is being sent in grateful acknowledgement of, and receipt for, the \$1,000 District Grant received by Interact District 5495 from Rotary District 5495.

It is understood that these funds are specifically designated to be used to help assist with the cost of shipping and trucking the 40-foot container of crutches, walkers, wheelchairs and other mobility devices that our Interact clubs in this district have collected this year and sent to our partners in Kenya.

The shipping container has been shipped by Kenya by our partner Rotarian nonprofit organization, Crutches 4 Africa, at a total cost for shipping, customs fees and trucking of the container from the port to Naivasha, the location from which the mobility devices will be distributed, of \$7,000. The Crutches 4 Africa organization has advanced the funds to cover these costs. Our Interact District 5495 will be reimbursing the Crutches 4 Africa for these transportation expenses. The first \$500 has been paid to them, and the balance of the funds will be sent by the end of this month, when our Interact Ambassadors team leaves for Kenya to assist with the distribution.
