Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

An 'After School Edge' learning workstation was installed at the Holdrege Public Library. The workstation is aimed at students 6-14 years of age. The unit contains over 50 top-rated educational software titles and is aimed at extending learning from school hours to after school and spans the curriculum spectrum from reading and math to reference and the arts.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 1

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Our Library Director, Rotarian Pam Soreide, is the director for the Holdrege Area Public Library and was instrumental in implementing the program, and was responsible for ordering and installing the equipment. Children's Librarian Cindy Gitt has been working with children to use the learning programs. Rotarian Bob Butz visited the library to see the equipment, which was in use at the time, and to take pictures to share with the club.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 1132

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Of the 1238 children between 5 and 14 in Phelps County, 1132 have active library cards and are the targeted demographic for this equipment. As 23% of the households in Phelps County have a household income of \$25,000 or less, we anticipate that this equipment will provide a fun learning environment that fosters independent, self-paced learning for many children who do not otherwise have access to computers. The expected outcome of providing this equipment in an environment that is open to be used outside of school hours (afternoons, evenings, weekends and during school breaks), is to improve reading and writing skills, math and problem-solving skills, and provide exposure to art, science, and social studies, and help hone computer skills such as keyboarding and understanding user interfaces. It is an important adjunct to the library's Summer Reading program, the goal of which is to foster literacy and to help retain learning that goes on during the school year. The unit is not connected to the Internet in any way, making it unnecessary to gain parental permission for access, unlike our Children's Internet workstations.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

The Future Fund is associated with the Phelps County Community Foundation, and provides grants to help provide community assets, particularly focusing on youth. The Future Fund provided partial funding for this equipment.
