
Project Title Dictionary Project

Dictionaries were provided to approximately 350 third graders in our community. Each Rotarian worked in pairs to deliver these to the local third graders during the months of October and November. The four way test was also reviewed at each school.

Rotarians also worked with High School Students to place a sticker of the four way test in each of the dictionaries that were then distributed to the third graders.

Students will have a better understanding of Rotary and the four way test as well as be able to benefit from the use of the dictionary.
