The Rotary District 5400 committee is grateful for the District grant that allowed us to provide scholarships for students for the 2018-2019 academic year. We are proud to file the following report.

The District 5400 college scholarship programs supports a student for all four years of their education at an Idaho institution for \$1,000 per year. This year, due to the committee chairs failure to file the report for 2017-2018 in a timely manner, our committee was awarded \$3,000 through the district grant process and the balance of \$1,000 was to be made up by another source.

The committee reached out in the summer of 2018 to the three students who were eligible for continued support of the scholarships as long as they continued to meet all of the criteria as set forth in the application. Two of those students, Makia Perez (Scholes) and Addie White had successfully met all of the criteria and provided documentation to support the continuation of their awards. One student, Drake Heubach, did not provided the required materials despite numerous attempts to contact him. Therefore, he was not awarded funds and funds were not requested to support him.

The committee was comprised of eight (8) Rotary members from throughout the District. The committee advertised for candidates for the 2018-2019 awards and seventeen applications were reviewed by the committee. The committee unanimously chose Maya Webber, a freshman at BYU-Idaho as the recipient of the award. Each of the successful students were awarded \$500 in the fall and \$500 in the spring upon documentation of their grade point averages and status as students. The District office was requested to send the awards to the students.

The gift of an education is one of the most life-changing events that can happen for students. This program allows our recipients to achieve their dreams of a higher education while relieving some of the financial stresses of being student. They are deeply grateful for the support.
