

Clean Water Initiative Crow Creek, WY – GutterBins P-2270 Final Report

The Rotary Clubs of Cheyenne (Sunrise, Cheyenne and After Hours) along with our Rotary Partners of Rotaract and Interact in partnership with the Laramie Country Conservancy District (LCCD), Crow Creek Revival (CCR) with its local sponsors and Frog Creek Partners, LLC proposed a clean water project to purchase, install and maintain eight Gutter Bins as part of phase 1 of our clean water commitment to help prevent future contamination of Crow Creek as it passes through Cheyenne, Wyoming.

In June 2018, a District grant of \$4000 was awarded.

Between June 2018 and March 2019, the Rotary Clubs raised the \$4000 in matching funds.

Considerable time and effort was expended to coordinate the installation of the GutterBins with the City of Cheyenne, the Cheyenne City Council, Cheyenne City Engineer and the Wyoming Department of Transportation.

On May 13, 2019 twelve GutterBins were installed. Eight of the GutterBins were purchased by Rotary and the remaining four Gutterbins were purchased by the Laramie County Conservation District (via separate non-Rotary grant).

The twelve GutterBins are forecast to catch as much as 1000lbs or more of trash/sediment in the coming year.

Ongoing maintenance of the GutterBins will be needed (to empty bins of trash) in the coming months, however, the May 13, 2019 installation of the Gutterbins completes P-2270 and all payments/expense are accounted for.
