- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
This program provided oral health and nutrition days at two elementary schools in the Whittier City School District, on April 19 and April 26, providing free dental screenings, fluoride treatment, oral health and nutrition education, and referral to care to low income elementary age children. Each of the more than 800 participants received an oral health kit comprised of a toothbrush, tooth paste, floss, timer and educational material (in English or Spanish).

- What did they do? Please give at least two examples.
Rotarians handed out the oral health kits at Hoover School and at Jackson School.
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? More than 700 students, plus their families, benefited.
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?
Better oral health equals better attention in school, better energy to accomplish tasks, more success and less financial strain on the family. Furthermore, family members of the students benefit as well, as the students share what they learn with their parents and siblings.
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?
The Children's Health Foundation, aka Children's Health Clinic, provided the professional programming.
