

Project Description

- **1.**The Rotary partnered with the Alliance for Safe Kids, Inc. (ASK) to introduce and develop an evidence-based, researched program for Community Understanding and Supporting Youth Mental Health. The project included:
 - Obtained the educational license of The Youth Mental Health Project's film *No Letting Go* with unlimited community screening availability for one year.
 - Hosted a community screening of The Youth Mental Health Project's film No Letting Go followed by a facilitated conversation led by the Founder and Executive Director of The Youth Mental Health Project, Randi Silverman. This event allowed Ms. Silverman to properly introduce The Parent Support Network Yorktown, a revolutionary and replicable model for parent-driven, family focused support meetings for parents who have children between the ages of 0 and 24 years old who struggle with their mental health. The community event took place on April 29, 2019 at the Yorktown Stage in Yorktown Heights, NY. The audience was comprised of every sector of the community as well as those from neighboring areas. Additional screenings are planned for the remainder of the project period.
 - Sponsored the acquisition of educational and awareness booklets: *Understanding Youth Mental Health Questions Parents Frequently Ask, Mental Health 101, Understanding and Supporting Youth Mental Health.* These materials have been shared, and will continue to be shared at a variety of community events and location. Some of the events and locations are as follows: ASK Save A Life Mental Health and Substance Abuse Prevention Forum; Community Screening(s) of *No Letting Go*; District Level PTA Meetings; School District Leadership and Clinical Staff of Four Area Districts; Faith Based Organizations; Civic Groups; Youth Sports Associations; Medical Offices: Pediatric, Orthodontic, Urgent Care; Scouts; Town Government; Westchester County Coalitions; Westchester County Department of Community Mental Health; Community and School District Events.
 - Conducted, and will continue to conduct, surveys to measure impact for both *No Letting Go* and the booklets.
- **2.** Given the wide reach that the informational materials have been shared with and will continue to be shared with, as well as the audience that has viewed and will view *No Letting Go*, it is safe to that 1000+ will benefit from this project.

3. The beneficiaries of this project were/are: Families, Faith Based Youth Programs, Youth Athletes, Scouts, Youth Leaders, Teachers, Seniors, Any Participating Community Member. We all have mental health, just like we have physical health. Yorktown has experienced an increased rate of youth anxiety, depression and suicide. The stigma associated with youth mental health prevents valuable conversation to better understand and support our community. Stereotypes, discrimination and fear, cultivate deafening silence around youth mental health. Untreated mental health conditions can lead to desperate situations and families cannot seek help for a problem if they do not know it exists. This project offered an opportunity to educate, empower and support families and the community so they will have knowledge, skills, and resources they need to support the social, emotional, mental and behavioral health of youth.

4. # of Rotarians

- **5.** The Rotarians that participated in the project did so in various ways. The Rotarians shared awareness of the community screening of *No Letting Go* and facilitated discussion, as well as the printed resources at the ASK Save A Life Mental Health and Substance Abuse Prevention Forum. It was crucial that the Rotarians shared the opportunity of the film screening and facilitated conversation with their connections within the community. This was done successfully by promoting the event at meetings and on social media. The Rotarians were also in attendance at the community screening. They helped with set up, greeting the community members in attendance, managed check in and distributed resources to attendees, and by attending they are now able to continue to spread awareness of upcoming screenings and the availability of educational resources.
- **6.** The Alliance for Safe Kids, Inc. (ASK) is the cooperating organization involved in this project. ASK's mission is to support youth mental health, as well as, prevention of substance use/abuse and other destructive behaviors damaging to our youth. ASK is a collaboration within the community parents, teens, educators, law enforcement, government, medical professionals, businesses, faith based organizations, civic groups aimed at providing youth with the information and skills needed to make healthy decisions while emphasizing the need for families to protect and nurture their children by getting informed and staying involved. By partnering with all areas of the community, we collectively strengthen the safety net that protects our youth.

ASK acted as the liaison between the Rotary and all vendors/partners for this project as well as shared the opportunities and resources with every sector of the community.

 ASK managed all communications with The Youth Mental Health Project, scheduled the speaker, secured contracts, worked with graphic designer to order all printed materials with logos.

- ASK secured space the event venue and secured all technical needs for the community event on April 29.2019.
- ASK managed all event marketing needs.
- ASK used their email database and social media platforms to promote and share awareness of the opportunities and information that the Rotary was providing the community with.
- ASK shared the opportunities and resources at all meetings and community events that they attended.
