## Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? \_\_\_\_\_

The Boys and Girls Club of Burkburnett purchased a 24 foot by 24 foot play-ground canopy to provide shade and protection from the sun's UV rays. The vertical poles for each corner have been erected and bolted in place. The canopy structure will be installed when the weather permits. The playground equipment is located next to the main facility and is used by approximately 160 youth each day

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Two

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

They stood up four 18 foot, steel poles and placed them over the bolts in the concrete foundation. They used levels to ensure the poles were plumb (straight up and down) and then bolted them in place. A total of four poles – one at each corner. They will next assist in installing the canopy structure when the weather permits

4. How many Noon-Rotarians participated in the project? Eight

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? The playground canopy will provide shade throughout the day to approximately 160 youth who use it. The canopy will protect these kids from the UV rays of our hot summer sun. The shade will keep the equipment cooler and allow the children much longer times to be out on this equipment.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? The Boys and Girls Club Board of Directors assisted in pouring the concrete structure needed as the foundation for the vertical support poles.
