Project Title: Interact Pool Pavilion

### Project Description:

2. Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were involved?

The Kemmerer Interact Club planned and administered this project that included removal of a tree and replacement of the grassy area adjacent to the pool with a concrete pad and a shade structure. The tree provided little shade to pool patrons and its leaves clogged up the pool filters. The new structure provides both shade and a clean easy-to-maintain poolside area for patrons. The project took place at the local outdoor pool, benefitting the Kemmerer/Diamondville communities. The local Interact and Rotary chapters worked with the City of Kemmerer, Kemmerer Lion's Club, and local businesses in a cooperative effort to improve the outdoor pool facilities.

Interact members and Rotarians cut down, cut up, loaded, and donated the wood from the tree that was removed to a family in need. Additionally, Rotarians and Interact members shoveled dirt out of the area that was to become the concrete pad.

Rotary funds covered materials up to the amount allotted. The Lion's club funded the rest of the project. The sign noting the project and giving thanks to those who contributed was a cost that was not considered when the project was proposed, but was deemed necessary upon completion. Since there were still funds left in the budget we decided to purchase the sign giving credit to Rotary, Interact, and all others who contributed. Pictures are included.
