Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

We have had many meal packing sessions for Feed My Starving Children in the last year. Many have taken place at the Feed My Starving Children facility in Tempe, Arizona, and several have taken place at larger venues in the Phoenix, Tucson and Prescott areas.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 100s

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

There are 7 positions at each packing station. Two people scoop vitamins and minerals, freeze-dried vegetables, rice and soy into a funnel; two people take turns holding the bag under the funnel and weighing the bag; two people seal the bags; and one person boxes up the finished bags. There are anywhere from 50 to 100s of stations.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Millions

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

These meals are sent to starving children in 70 countries on an ongoing basis.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?


We established a partnership with Feed My Starving Children, the organization that prepares and sends the meals.
