Their vision is to empower all children to become lifelong learners by providing access to a quality preschool program that supports school readiness. Enrollment at the time of the grant was 88 students.				
	This grant focused on two aspects of literacy for the students at the pre-school. 1, Zoo Phonics: This program maximized understanding, memory, utilization and transference to all areas of the reading, spelling and writing process in a playful and concrete manner. And 2. Link to Learning: This program supported parents in teaching their children at home by providing books to use at home and began to build their library at home. Many of these families were in a lower income status and could not afford to buy books for their children.
