### Project Description:

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1. Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were involved?

**Project involved purchase, delivery and distribution of clothing items – by individual sizes – to children in Agua Blanca Mexico, a remote town in Sonora, MX. For some the clothes made the difference as to whether they could attend school.**

2. How many Rotarians participated in this project? **6 US Rotarians, 6 Mexican Rotarians+ their wives, 13 Interact students and 1 exchange student (Ecuador) from our club.**
3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

**Drove to Agua Blanca - 1 ½ hours – delivered clothes to children, played soccer and baseball with children. Shared lunch prepared by community members as a thank you.**

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? **30 children**

5. Who are the beneficiaries and what is the expected long-term community impact of this project? **Children able to attend school with purchased clothing. Community support and appreciation for Rotary (both US group and Rotarians from their nearest city of Agua Prieta) Also, Interact students gained perspective on the level of poverty in the area and an appreciation for the impact they could have on the lives of the children. And that language makes no difference when playing!**
