Project Description:

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were involved?

This annual project served the senior population within Casper, Mills, Evansville, Bar Nunn, Wyoming and the surrounding Natrona County area with the installation of smoke and carbon monoxide alarms to provide a greater outreach for Fire and Life Safety and the prevention of falls. All alarms have 10 year batteries, not requiring battery changes. Each home is registered now with the Fire Departments and will be revisited every 10 years for alarm replacements.

It involved approximately 90 volunteers and over 90 senior homes were provided with smoke and carbon monoxide alarms.

2. How many Rotarians participated in this project?

30 plus family, community and fire department volunteers

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

The installations occurred on April 6, 9 and 13, 2019. Rotarians and volunteers were grouped in teams of three. Each team installed alarms in 3 to 4 homes covering a total of over 110 homes. Each team provided the home occupants with fire safety information and discussed fall protection concerns. Each team also installed night lights and replaced burned out light bulbs.

5. Who are the beneficiaries and what is the expected long-term community impact of this project?

The beneficiaries of this project were seniors and homebound individuals. The community impact is saving lives by providing fire protection and saving falls by seniors not having to change batteries, since the alarms installed don't require battery changes.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was their role?

A total of 9 fire stations around the County were involved and the Casper Fire – EMS Department provided the administration for registering and logging each home and address.

The Casper College Fire Science Program also provided 12 students and the Casper College Honor Society provided 5 volunteers as part of their annual giving program.
