- 3. Project description: Attend the Project Fair in Antigua, Guatemala. George Gerard and Eileen Carney attended. Originally Mick Shea and Linda Gerard were also planning to attend but scheduling conflicts arose which prevented their attendance. The Project Fair had over 50 exhibits and over 150 attendees, which enabled us to learn about other clubs and projects as well as other resources.
- 4. Community impact: The purpose of a Project Fair is to connect projects with potential donors, so there was no direct impact on community members. However \$20,000 was raised for the waster project at the community of La Vega with a population of over 1,300, and a list of other potential donors was secured.
- 5. Other funding: On January 27,28, and 29 we visited the communities of El Progresso, La Vega, and Pasac, site of our current projects. All expenses for this phase of the trip were paid for by George Gerard and Eileen Carney and were not included in the project budget.
- 6. How was Rotary identified: The Project Fair is put on by Rotarians for Rotarians so Rotary signage was everywhere. The La Vega booth was well identified by the two Kalispell clubs as well as the Sustainable Global Coalition.
- 7. Rotarian hours: The booths were open on January 24, 25 and 26. At least two Rotarians were manning the booth at all times. A total of seven Rotarians contributed an estimated 98 hours to this project.
