On November 12, 2013 from 5-7pm the Hastings Sunrise Rotary Club hosted Night at the Museum at the Hastings Museum. Sunrise Rotarians and Hastings Museum staff members joined forces to provide a fun-filled night at the museum to underprivileged families of the Hastings community. Children and their families were treated to a movie at the Lied IMAX Theater and had free reign to explore the wonderful exhibits at the museum. Afterwards they were treated to cookies and Kool-Aid. No admission was charged.

Underprivileged kids of the Hastings community along with their families were treated to free museum and movie admission. They were able to enjoy all the educational and cultural exhibits the museum has to offer. From many of the kids this was their first time at the Museum. Also 26 people from the local homeless shelter attended the event.

The Hastings Museum provided free admission and staff to operate the movie theater and planetarium. Over \$3000 in free museum and movie tickets were provided.
