1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? List any changes that might have occurred.
The Computer server for the YMEN organization was delivered on Nov. 9th, 2019. An effort was made to install the system as soon as possible. Unfortunately, the Rotary volunteer from Rotary One (Karl Zimmerman) who was supposed to install the unit, passed away as the installation was getting underway. YMEN, however, found additional assistance and according to Marcus Thorne, Program Director, YMEN of Chicago, the unit is now up and running. There is great appreciation for the contribution of the server at YMEN.
2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 7
3. What did they do? Please give at least 2 examples. A. Work was done on getting the correct type of server for the YMEN (Karl Zimmerman) B. Worked with vendor to get the best price on the unit (Tom Norton) C. Cooperated and worked to get Rotary One involved directly with the project (Marshall Schmitt)
4. How many non-Rotarians benefitted from this project? 250 students
5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? This computer server has substantially upgraded the educational capacity of the organization. Now, instead of operating just individual computers, YMEN is capable of pushing out school wide educational program and public service announcements.
6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Rotary One of Chicago contributed \$700 and the technical assistance of Member Karl Zimmerman. As noted, tragically, Karl passed away as the installation was in progress.
7. How did you share the news of your project? We announced this to the District, the club, and posted stories on our website.
