4th grade in Woot River next year.

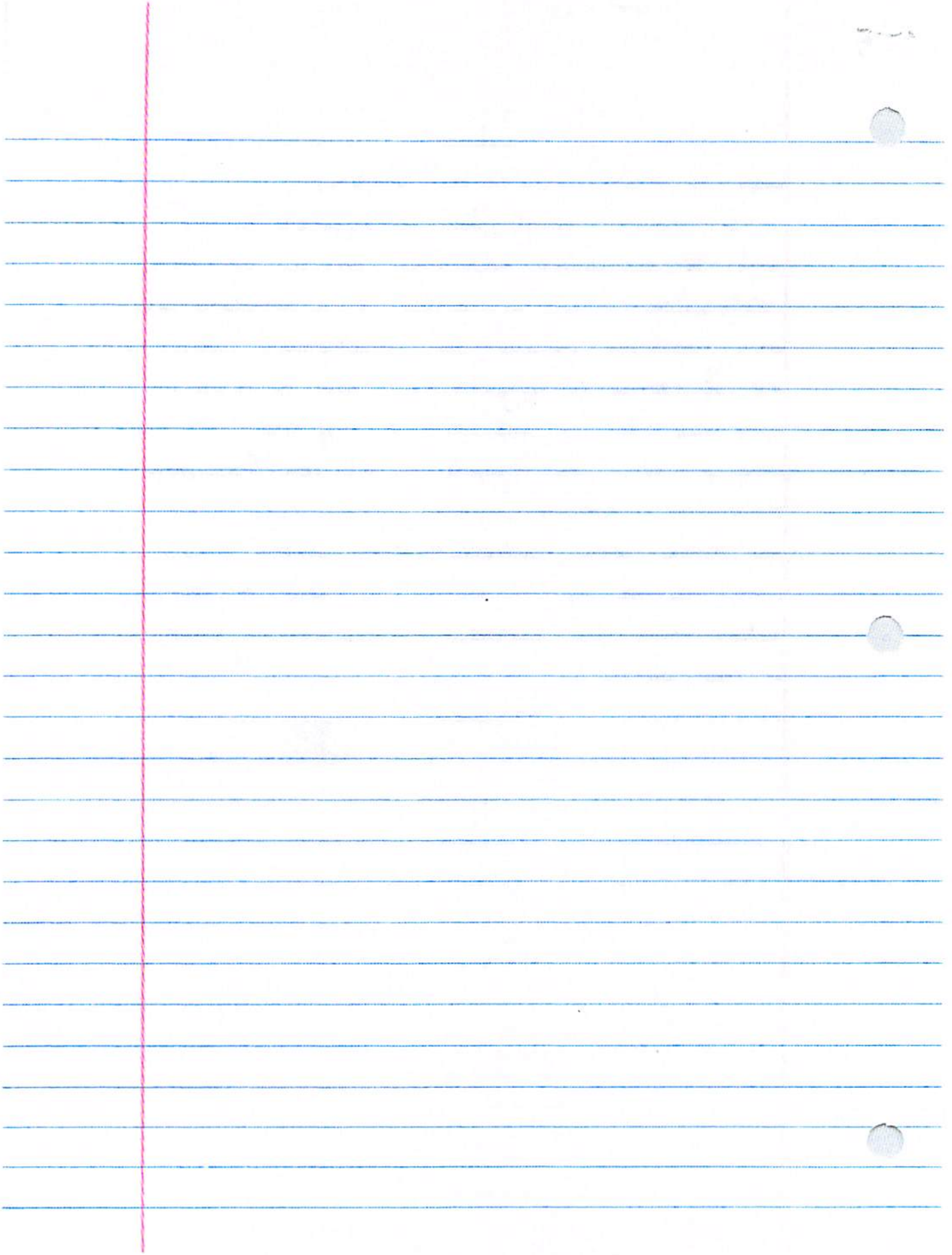
