**Project Description.** What was done in 110 words or less? Chino Valley Rotary Club partnered with the Chino Valley Unified School District (CVUSD) and Mingus Springs Charter School (MSCS), to challenge the students to read, the cornerstone of the project is the software used to test the students' comprehension of each book read, and records the number of words in the book. Rotary Club members visited each school quarterly to give a party for the highest reading class in each grade - root beer floats or pizza parties. Rotarians attended each school's year-end award ceremony, where Million Word Readers are recognized, and given a certificate, as well as Amazon Gift Cards. Top readers receive Kindles, and for the highest reader, an upgraded Kindle Fire.

**When (dates) and where (city and state) did the project take place?** The project took place during the 2019 calendar year in Chino Valley Arizona.

**Who were the beneficiaries?** Students of Chino Valley Unified School District

**How many Rotarians participated in this project?** 9

**What did the Rotarians do?** Give at least two examples: Throw quarterly recognition parties for the classes with highest amount of reading, and attend assemblies to give out kindles and certificates for Million Word Readers. Fund and work at banquet for Million Word Readers and their parents.

**How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?** All of the students who received class and/or individual awards approximately 800 students.

**If a cooperating organization was used, what was it's role?** Chino Valley Unified School District supplies the reading software at an approximate cost of \$18,000 per year, they also provide lanyards and pins as prizes to the students who meet the quarterly reading goal of 250,000 words read, which puts them on track to be a Million Word Reader by year end.


