The WRAP project continues to grow in importance – the grant was used to obtain the necessary training for two county facilitators – Rotarian Jessica McCaslin, and fellow mental health therapist Patsy Burnett.

Our biggest challenge – COVID-19 – which also accelerates the need.

The training which we originally thought was going to have to be obtained out of state, was offered in state through Nebraska Emergency Management. McCaslin and Burnett are now fully licensed in WRAP (Wellness Recovery Action Plan) with intent now that the state is opening up to continue their quest to better bring it to the community.
