**Project Title**      Shelter Box and Good Shepherd

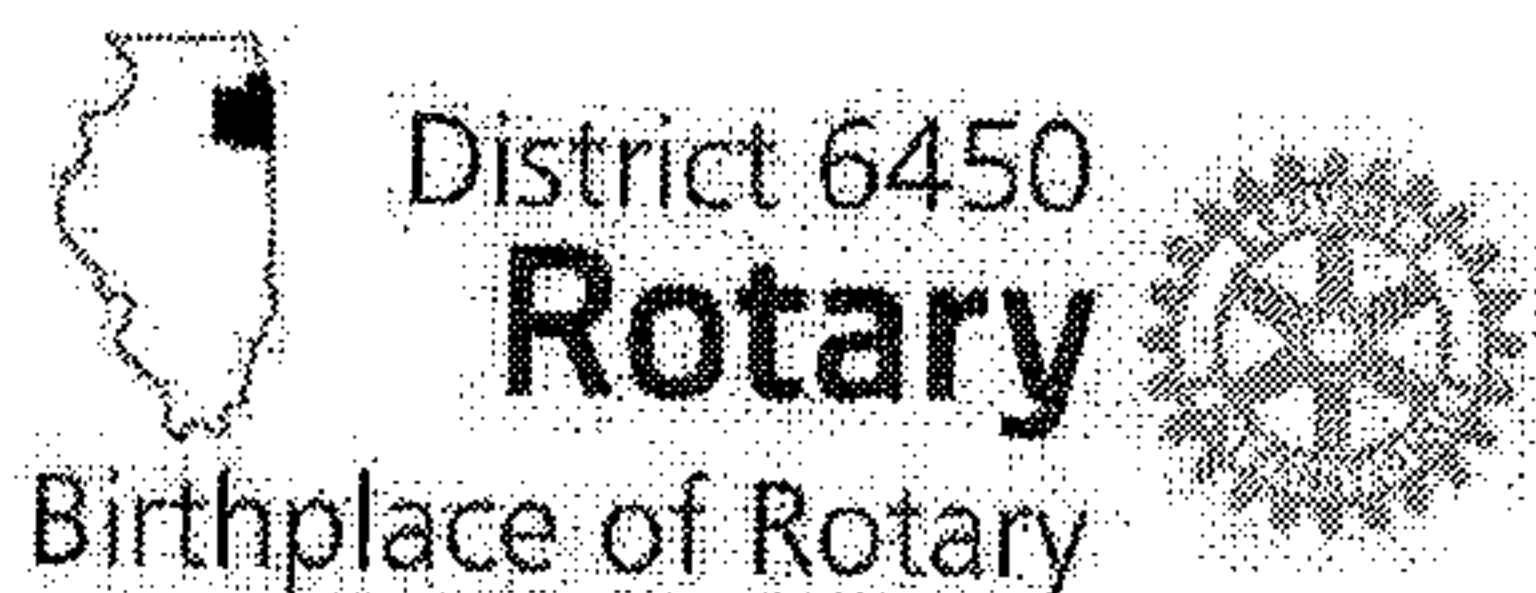
1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? List any changes that might have occurred
