This Project provided needed supplies including groceries, toiletries, gift cards, and bus passes. We also helped deliver the food supplies to 7 local High Schools twice a month.

Beneficiaries of this Project are the homeless and at-risk High School Students within the area who are provided with food, clothing, and other needs such as the life skills classes.
