This effort required relocation of the existing sprinkler system, leveling and building a engineered support wall and placement of concrete. The City of Scottsdale provided new tables for the expanded area as part of their joint improvement efforts.

The City of Scottsdale Parks and Recreation provide new tables which were installed at the expanded picnic area.

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
