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Project Description. What was done in 110 words or less?

The three Rotary clubs of Prescott joined with the Prescott Public Library, Friends of the Library, Prescott Unified School District and other partners to bring the Dolly Parton Imagination Library to our area. This literacy program provides families with birth to 5 YOA children with a childrens book each month with encouragement for parents to read to them. This is a 3 year commitment from the Rotary Clubs to help get it going and to allow it to become sustainable from other donations. When (dates) and where (city and state) did the project take place?

Began in October 2019 in Prescott, Arizona

Who were the beneficiaries?

Families with children aged Birth to 5 YOA

How many Rotarians participated in this project?

Three Rotarians participated in the Steering committee. Others attended the Kick-Off event.

The members of the planning committee helped formulate the program to be titled Prescott Imagination Library and applied for the grants to get it started . Members of all the clubs helped to circulate application flyers to various doctors offices and other venues where expecting families would be in contact and see the flyers.

How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

432 families registered children and received books each month until they pass 5 YOA.

If a cooperating organization was used, what was it's role?

The Prescott Public Library and Friends of the Library along with the Prescott Unified School District and other partners formed the steering committee along with members from the three rotary clubs. The Library and the Friends organization have supplied support staff and computer support to manage the program.

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
