The club put an educational page in the Craig Daily Press every Wednesday for a year. The original idea was to go into classrooms one Wednesday a month to work with K-5th graders on the various activities that were contained on the Kids Scoop page in the newspaper. It turned out that the school administration had did not agree to let us go into the classrooms since it was approved as part of the curriculum. So we improvised and met with groups of kids during various activities in the fall. We also brought the newspaper in with us and gave it to all second graders when we were meeting with them monthly for Book Buddies. Once Covid hit and the schools were closed we continued to put the page in the paper but no longer were able to meet with the kids.
