Project Title: Septic Tanks for families

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

YLSRC collaborates with Corazon to build homes for families in need in Tecate Mexico. As part of the evolution of the project we now add septic tanks to the homes we are building, which helps improve hygiene and prevent diseases in children and adults. We are also retrofitting previously built homes depending on budget availability. We have now installed 4 septic tanks and we were able to stretch the budget to acquire a total of 7 tanks. We are in a holding pattern until we can travel to Mexico again to install the final 3 tanks, anticipating access later this calendar year.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

During the house build as many as 30 Rotarians will assist. During other tank installations, 4 or 5 Rotarians will travel to Mexico to lead the program.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

An engineer leads the actual installation to ensure proper positioning of the tank. The engineer also ensures all plumbing is done correctly to ensure proper functioning of the system.

Rotarians help local people with the actual work and supervise the site safety.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

3 Corazon employees and the backhoe operator, as well as the homeowner, ie 5 people.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Long term health and reduction of sanitation borne disease.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Corazon is based in the USA and assists with family identification locally in Mexico. Corazon also provides personnel and administrative support locally and assists with labor.
