Build was initiated and completed on February 15, 2020 benefitting a family who earned the home through the Corazon organization. It additionally benefitted the community. Whether in raising food, working towards being financially independent and giving back.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 8 members of our club participated but the entire build was completed by Rotarians from our entire District. Two buses were used to transport Rotarians across the border and back home

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? A family now has a home. In order to qualify they had to purchase the lot and complete the various courses offered by Corazon and assist others in the community in building their homes. They built a home for a family but assisted in strengthening a community

Corazon identifies and works with the recipient family, helps them complete the requirements to qualify for the home, Manages the funds contributed to the project by the various Rotary clubs to buy materials for the home: lumber, paint, nails, roofing, etc
