## P-290 JUNGLE MEDICAL CLINICII – PROGRESS REPORT

## HEALTH CARE SERVICES AND EXPANSION SERVICES AT PUERTO EL FLOR, USULUTAN

With funding from International Rotary Club since 2011, OEF provides primary health care services to 174 families residing at Puerto Flor, with equipment, medicines provision, materials for educational talks, inputs for cleaning campaigns, incentives to families that demonstrate changes in health and home conditions, etc. from the which, the community has been benefitted with access to health services, and therefore, they already have a health clinic and a promoter living within the community, as well as improved health conditions and self-care of families served.

This initial work at Puerto Flor, since 2013 has resulted in the expansion of services, supporting education through a Levelling Classroom, attended by **50 children and adolescents** at high social risk with learning disabilities in alternate schedule to the school, thus ensuring a better use of their time, support for the completion of homework and thus a decrease in absenteeism and dropout rates, and an improvement in academic performance students, which ensures the passing to the next grade, reducing repetition.

In the same line of work, with children at social risk and working children, OEF has coordinated efforts with the German Embassy to improve the infrastructure of an educational center in the city of Usulután, ensuring a better environment for all students, contributing to the education quality.

Then, the initial support of the Rotary Club, has facilitated the diversification of services to 174 families living in Puerto Flor, with better access to health services, a Levelling Classroom for children and adolescents with learning disabilities, access to vocational training courses and business credit, which we know are some of the pillars for community development.
