### Project Summary

Phase 1 of this project supported District 9700 proposal to receive a delegation of young indigenous Australian professionals to D5610 to experience a different indigenous culture. The team will share experiences and connections to demonstrate the unique way Rotary works towards building understanding, peace and vocational excellence. D5610 supported this GSE with \$2500 grant.

The **Professional/vocational areas of the** indigenous professionals will be:

- Business operation and Indigenous art
- Community Arts – performance, visual, etc
- Justice
- Indigenous Health care
- Education – primary level (ages 7yrs to 12 yrs);  
secondary (ages 12yrs to 17yrs);  
sports; university level; vocational (college) level
- Land Care / Environment

Each participant will have expertise in one or more of these professions.

Phase 2 of this project will be to send counterpart Native Tribal Americans to Australia to mirror the experience of the Phase 1 Aboriginal Australians. This request will address phase 2, supporting the Native American delegation from District 5610 traveling to Australia. We will be sending Lakota, Dakota Nakota professionals matched to the aboriginal professionals, so that both can gain from this international exchange.

This District grant will fully fund our team's travel to Australia and return trip. The Australian Rotarians will have hosting duties of housing, transportation, and networking connections. Omniciye Rotarians, and District 5610 Rotarians engaged with Native American organizations will be consulted to provide personal connections to recruit candidates. Up to four team members will be recruited and funded. A Rotarins from Omniciye or District 5610 will be asked to volunteer to coordinate the US team. This grant is similar to a Scholarship grant that the District funds, therefore no single club is named to match funding.

Nation-building and vocational development for both indigenous peoples of Australia and Native Americans in South Dakota will be beneficial to the communities impacted.

Rotarians will interview and select candidates, confirm their membership in the team, and conduct pre-travel familiarity meetings. The team will be encouraged to work together to plan their greetings and presentations. Rotary clubs will likely host the team as they travel nearby. Any contributions to reduce the cost to the District will be used to reduce the total cost.
