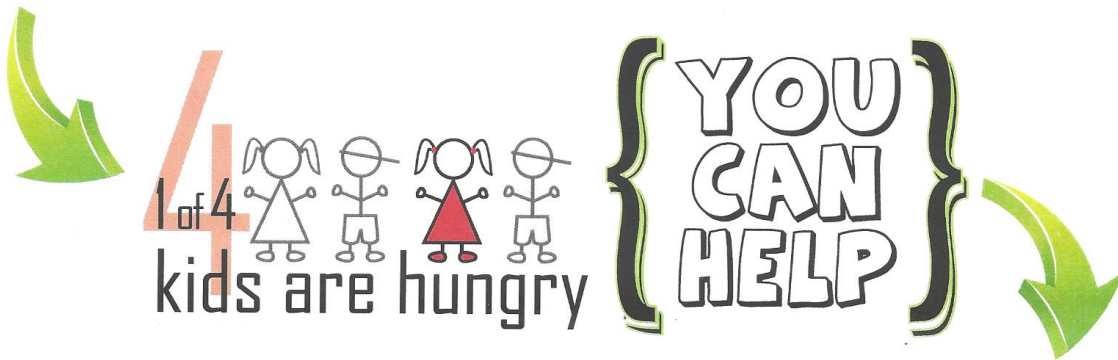

One of four kids in Tarrant County are hungry.

More than 121,000 children live in food insecure households all year long. The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) at Tarrant Area Food Bank (TAFB) helps bridge the gap during the summer months for those children who participate in free and reduced-price lunch and breakfast program during the school year.

With summer fast approaching, it is time to start gearing up for summer feeding. TAFB is partnering with the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) and the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) to provide nutritious meals to children 18 and younger at no cost during the summer months.



Partnering with Tarrant Area Food Bank's Summer Food Service Program is easy!



TAFB Food for Kids Department will handle the paperwork, order the food, have food delivered daily, and work with USDA and TDA to ensure that all food provided to the children meets the SFSP requirements.

Your site will need a Site Supervisor dedicated to overseeing the delivery and distribution of meals and who will attend training prior to SFSP starting, participate in site visits and keep accurate records of meals served.
