Project Title: Educational Scholarships

Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The project was to award \$1,000 scholarships to six students who were planning to attend college during the 2020-21 school year. Four scholarships awards were directed toward students from the Denton Independent School District Interact Clubs, and two scholarships were directed toward second- or third-year students from the two Denton colleges - the University of North Texas and Texas Womans University. Applications from interested students were reviewed by club members and district school officials in late April. The recipients were notified of their selection in early May, and checks were mailed to the students' college financial offices on May 16, 2020.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

70

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

(1) All 70 club members were involved in raising funds through the annual flag program and through portions of their dues designated to scholarships in the club budget.

(2) One member supervised the distribution of application information and the contact with Denton high school Interact advisors and Denton Rotaract advisors to encourage students to apply for a scholarship. That same member met with school principals and Interact advisors to oversee the selection process and created and distributed certificates to the selected scholarship awardees.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

This scholarship project will help further the education of worthy students and alleviate the cost of their tuition and partially alleviate their burden of accumulating debt that can occur in financing a college education currently. It also makes recipient students more aware of Rotary and its purposes, hopefully encouraging them to become a Rotarian in the future as they graduate and move on into their careers.
