Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

The grant from Anchorage East Rotary was used to purchase and install six computers with associated software for the newly renovated Clare House located at 4110 Spenard Road in Anchorage Alaska. The computers were installed in our computer/job enrichment center two phases: October 2013 and March 2014.

2. How many people benefited from this project? 402

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

The purpose of the project was to assist the Clare House resident women with children and expectant mothers over 18 and to help them in their transition from homelessness to independent living. Since project inception there have been 402 women and children residing at Clare House, the majority of whom have used the computers. Most women coming to Clare House have little knowledge of how to use a computer and therefore the computers are used by the women to gain the skills necessary to move to economic self-sufficiency and stable housing. The renovated Clare House allows for stays up to two years rather than the previous limit of 30 days. The 12 longer term progressive housing living units are currently full. The families living in these units pay rent and can stay for up to two years while they work on their plans to become self-sufficient. The computers purchased by Rotary are also used by youth living at Clare House to complete their homework. As a result the computer lab is in operation from 6 in the morning until 10 at night! I'm not sure what the women and children living at Clare House would do without these computers provided through the generous grant from Rotary.
