The ARK (Adults Relating to Kids) training program works to build the self-concept of a child by focusing on the child experiencing a relationship of unconditional love and care from an adult who is a primary in that child's life. In this case the counselor will facilitate the program on campus.

This grant will sponsor participation ARK programming at no or reduced cost at our sponsored school.
