Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

The Golden Heart Running Club was organized to support the wellness of school-aged children, ages 7 – 12, through physical activity during the summer months. The project's primary area of focus was child health.

The Golden Heart Running Club offered a free athletic experience for 13 nights during the 2013 summer, June – August, at Birch Hill Recreation Area, a local area attraction of trails and facilities. Golden Heart Rotarians volunteered as supervisors and coaches as part of our club's regular meeting schedule.

2. How many people benefited from this project? 50

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?
We engaged 36 children ages 7 – 12 through this club. Approximately 17 coaches (including Rotarians) helped at each practice. Children and adults benefitted from fun, physical exercise. Child health was the humanitarian need met through this activity.

Golden Heart Rotarians ran with children, encouraged and coached children, and helped keep children safe through organized check in / pick up practices.

Birch Hill Recreation Center allowed us to utilize their trails. Although the trails are for public, general use, they were so kind as to allow us to use their indoor hut for check in and snack distribution. We also rented their banquet hall for our awards ceremony.


