- 3. Briefly describe grant and any changes that might have occurred.

  The original grant requested funding for our club's efforts to support the Clairemont
  Community which is not served by a local Rotary Club. This included a request for \$300 in
  funding for dictionaries, funding for several RYLA participants and a \$500 scholarship for
  Clairemont High School. The scope was adjusted to follow RI's priority for funding of younger
  children and was limited to the purchase of dictionaries. A count of the dictionaries needed
  for all four of the Mission Bay 3rd graders and for two schools in Clairemont was generated
  and permission was received from Marge Cole to fund these four schools with project funds.
  The dictionaries have just arrived and labels have been printed. Our two Interact Clubs
  (Mission Bay and Clairemont) will be included in the distribution of the dictionaries over the
  next few weeks.
- 4. Provide a brief of lessons learned in implementing this grant.
- 5. How has your Club or community been impacted by this grant? See checklist
  The teachers in our schools indicate that this is one of the most valuable programs in the school. Third graders are Just learning to use resources like a dictionary and many kids do not have this resource at home. This grant enables us to assist the Clairemont Community and hopefully expand the awareness of Rotary's work to a broader community than the Mission Bay area.
- 6. Given your experience, please provide any suggestions you believe would improve District Grants and the process to receive and implement them. In terms of finding out about grants to participate in, I believe the District could run a grants fair with projects submitted by clubs. Some clubs view themselves more as funders than idea generators. We need both to have successful projects. It is difficult to connect clubs who need support with those interested in funding. A project fair would facilitate this and give funders a chance to evaluate more than one option. I also believe that the report form should be a fillable form or at least a word document that could be typed into.
